Club Tonomo



Located in the Outaouais mountains, Club Tonomo (“the Club”) offers a unique combination of rustic comfort, natural beauty and complete privacy. Guests are able to relax in its red pine log lodge,

overlooking the crystal clear waters of Lac Terreur (Lake Terror), or explore over six and a half square kilometers of wilderness.

The Club’s beautiful surroundings and four private lakes offer a variety of outdoor activities including canoeing, swimming, fishing, hunting and hiking during the spring and fall. Cross country skiing, snow shoeing and skating are among the winter activities. Nature enthusiasts can enjoy miles of trails throughout the property from which to observe the abundant wildlife in its natural setting. There are also provincial snowmobile trails within minutes of the Club.

Its location, facilities and services make the Club an ideal destination for company retreats, training sessions or corporate reviews – away from office distractions. It is also the perfect destination for family and friends to get together.

Accommodations



Two categories of accommodations are available to our guests. The Main Lodge and New Lodge, which are included as a set, are fully furnished and come with a range of services. The Bear Lake Cottage is a comfortable but rough cottage with simple amenities for the more adventurous clients.



The Main Lodge includes two large living room areas (each with its own fireplace), a dining room, a full kitchen, ten bedrooms and four fully equipped bathrooms. It also includes a billiards table, small library, satellite TV and washing and drying facilities (upon request). Capacity is between 22 and 30 guests.



The New Lodge, built in 2003 largely from the property’s own pine trees, houses the conference room and the main dining room facility. The top floor includes three bedrooms and a full bathroom for an additional eight guests.

The Bear Lake Cottage, newly constructed in 2008, again from the properties trees, is a rustic 24’X36’ cottage with simple kitchen, dining & living room, bathroom and living quarters for up to six guests. Although rustic, the cottage includes hot and cold running water, wood stove and gas powered lighting.

Guest services

The Club’s caretakers and cooks, Barbara and Jean, always ensure the most comfortable and relaxing stay possible for all guests.

A number of fishing boats and electric motors are available for rent. The Club also maintains hiking trails throughout the property.

Guests of the Main Lodge/New Lodge can prepare their own meals but most opt to indulge themselves with Barbara and Jean’s delicious home style cooking, prepared and served in the New Lodge.

High speed internet is also available from the New Lodge upon request.

For golfers, the Royal Papineau www.royalpapineau.com with its beautiful 18 hole course is located 15 minutes away. During winter, the Edelweiss ski center www.mssi.ca is only a 25 min drive from the Club.
